

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES OF
CASTON SCHOOL CORPORATION**

**June 15, 2022
6:30 P.M.**

Board President, Chad Boldry, called the June 15, 2022, meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance at 6:30 P.M. Celebrations: Caston's graduating class of 2022 held their ceremony on Sunday, June 5, 2022. Congratulations to Sam Smith, Class Valedictorian, and Salutatorian, Jacob Paschen. Congratulations to Caston's Boys' Baseball Team and coach Blake Mollenkopff and his coaching staff for a winning season. The baseball team won the sectional championship but fell short of a regional win.
